Job Posting Registered Nurse Pre-Op/PACU Services

Description: We are currently seeking a full-time registered nurse to work in PACU (Phase I & II) and Pre-op providing patient care including assessment, planning and implementing a perioperative, pre-procedural and post-procedural plan of care. The staff nurse utilizes the nursing process for patient care in all surgical specialties supported by The Black Canyon Surgical Center.

- Duties:**
- 1) Uses acceptable standards of practice based on nursing process care to provide the individual/family/group with identified perioperative needs.
 - 2) Coordinates care of the individual/family/group based on AORN Standards of Care.
 - 3) Is accountable for ethical, legal, and professional responsibilities related to nursing within the scope of practice.
 - 4) Performs initial assessment, admits and prepares patient for appropriate surgical/special procedure. Acts as a liaison between operative team and family. Provides postoperative care and support. Implements discharge plan. Provides specialized treatments and procedures, patient and family teaching. Provides professional, courteous, and emphatic service to a population ranging from infants to adults.

Occupational Exposure: Category I exposure to bloodborne pathogens, frequent exposure to chemical hazards and may encounter radiation hazards.

Qualifications: Licensure as Registered Nurse in the State of Colorado, Current CPR and ACLS certification, demonstrates ability to stand and/or walk at least five hours per day, demonstrates ability to lift and/or carry over 20 pounds on a regular basis, demonstrates ability to push/pull over 25 pounds on a regular basis.

Experience: Orientation is based on knowledge and experience. BLS, ACLS, PALS required. BLS required. ACLS & PALS required within 6 months. One year of acute care experience is required.

Job Knowledge: Encompass a wide range of nursing, psycho-social and medical information which includes nursing process, communication and problem solving, assessment and prioritizing skills.

Salary Range: \$28.26 - \$42.39/hr. Compensation for this role will depend on a number of factors, including candidate's qualifications, skills, competencies and experience.
